WHAT IS CHANGING?

The Town may refuse to open a utility account if A tenant has an outstanding balance from another account, has been disconnected for nonpayment three or more times, or has previously had a past-due account with the Town sent to a third-party collection agency In order to protect the overall tax rate for the average ratepayer, the following changes have been made to the Waterworks Bylaw:



2 Outstanding payment penalties will be applied to the account's total outstanding balance, rather than just the current balance
